The Directors and Management require all employees handling information and data to ensure the following:

- Comply with the company GDPR statement and practices.
- Ensure strong passwords are used at all times and keep passwords and user accounts secure.
- Request approval from management prior to installing any new software or hardware on any company equipment.
- Report information security incidents or concerns without delay, to the Directors and Senior Technical Manager responsible.
- Attend regular training on information security.

All staff authorised to handle sensitive card holder data will also comply with the following:

- Handle card holder information in a manner that fits with the sensitivity of the data.
- Ensure credit card details are not recorded in written or digital formats.
- Use only authorised platforms to process credit card payments (Global Payments).
